

BFG INSTALLATION ACCESS PASS FOR BRITISH VETERANS
Guide to the application process

If you have not already registered with the Veterans' Support Initiative please fill out the form on www.bfgnet.de/BFGvets.html

Contact your nearest Pass Office and make an appointment: details from www.bfgnet.de/BFGvets.html

Pass Office will give you the security questionnaire (BFG Form 28E) OR you can download it from www.bfgnet.de/BFGvets.html

Complete BFG Form 28E

Army Form B108X or equivalent

You will also need to show your Certificate of Service -issued by unit on discharge if available OR letter from CO.**

**If this document is unavailable this process may take longer

Obtain Police Clearance Certificate (Polizeiliches Führungszeugnis – PFZ) from Stadt Einwohnermeldeamt (at your own expense). **This must show your current address**

Return to Pass Office with completed questionnaire, Certificate of Service, PfZ, passport/identity card and 2 passport sized photographs.

You will be notified on successful completion of vetting process and the Veterans Access Installation Pass will be issued to you in person from the Pass Office you first contacted.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES.

(STATEMENT OF MEMORANDUM)

1. As a holder of a BFG Installation Access Pass for Veterans, I acknowledge the following:

1.1. That I will comply with all relevant BFG orders, instructions or regulations whilst present on BFG installations.

1.2 That all persons and their personal property (including vehicles) may be searched upon entry, whilst present on, or on exit from BFG installations. Persons attempting to gain entry who refuse to identify themselves, consent to search, or follow any lawful instruction given by a person authorised by BFG will be denied access.

1.3 That I may be accompanied by a maximum of four non-Pass holders, who are family members, when entering a BFG installation, so long as the details of those non-Pass holders are recorded on entry and verified by my signature in accordance with local procedures. I understand that I will be responsible for ensuring that I accompany any such non-Pass holders throughout the time that they are present on a BFG installation, and for ensuring that such non-Pass holders are aware of, and comply with, all relevant BFG orders, instructions and regulations.

1.4 That BFG Veterans Installation Passes are British Government property. Any commissioned or non-commissioned officer in the British Army, security guard, or any other person authorised by BFG may confiscate a Pass in any reasonable circumstances, including where the holder has breached any relevant BFG order, instruction or regulation, or where the Pass has expired, is being used fraudulently or has been altered, damaged or mutilated.

1.5 That I must surrender my pass when it expires, is no longer required, or when asked to do so in accordance with paragraph 1.4 above.

1.6 That if I lose my installation pass or it is stolen, I must immediately notify either the Royal Military Police or the office that issued the pass.
