

INTRODUCTION OF AN INCREASE TO THE THIRTY DAY TIMEFRAME FOR BFG REGISTRATION

All BFG personnel are advised that, with effect 01 Mar 11, the current 30 day timeframe allowed for BFG registration is to be increased to 45 days. Under the new 45 day timeframe the following processes must be completed before the application for registration is submitted to the BFG VLO.

- a. The BFG lights test or roadworthiness test must be completed.
- b. Pass BFG Matrix Test and obtain BFG Driving Permit (BFG Form 57).

The only exception will be to those vehicles that are going to be registered using an Allocation Certificate, i.e. vehicles coming from a Bonded Area or sometimes from NAAFI Car Sales. In such cases, the vehicle will only be registered for 45 days and the BFG lights test must be completed and registration renewed within this period.

The current 30 day timeframe will continue to be accepted until 31 May 11. Thereafter any applications not complying with the above will be rejected. This new timeframe will, with the exception of those vehicles being registered with an Allocation Certificate, remove the need to renew registration thirty days after initial registration.
