

## PASSPORT FEE CHANGES

The following Consular Fees will take effect from **3 September 2009** Fees are only payable in local currency. If you are applying by post, we recommend payment by bank transfer. **RATE OF EXCHANGE: - £1 = Euro 1.20**

1.	Processing an application to replace an expired passport, replacing a passport of restricted validity *, issuing a new passport with amended personal details, replacing a lost/stolen passport and, if the application is successful:  Issuing a ten-year passport to an adult. (Fee 14a) Issuing a five-year passport to a child. (Fee 14b)	£124.50 = Euro 149.00 £ 79.50 = Euro 95.00
3.	Issuing an emergency passport valid for a single journey to the United Kingdom. (Fee 16)	£ 69.00 = Euro 83.00
4.	Frequent Traveller Passport. (Fee 15)	£150.50 = Euro 181.00
5.	Call out Fee Per Hour – Out of office hours at office premises and elsewhere. (Fee 45b)	£128.00 = Euro 154.00
6.	Postage and Administration fee (non-BFPO addresses)	Euro 7.00

**\* Restricted validity passports (restricted after 01/04/2008) may no longer be extended gratis.**

**Unsuccessful and withdrawn applications will not be refunded.**
