

REGISTRATION AT MEDICAL CENTRES ON RETURN TO THE UNITED KINGDOM

Service families returning to UK ahead of their Serviceperson may be required to supply proof of identity and entitlement when registering with a GP practice in the UK.

Some Primary Care Trusts (the organisations who regulate GP practices) are requesting proof of identity and entitlement from anyone, regardless of nationality, who has been out of the UK for more than 3 months and who intends staying in the UK for longer than 6 months. You may be asked to produce:

- Marriage Certificate
- Photo identity
- Official letter from unit

If you are returning to UK in advance of your Serviceperson you are advised to obtain a letter of confirmation from your current unit **prior** to your move.
