

The 2010 Winston Churchill Travelling Fellowships

The Winston Churchill Memorial Trust are looking for Travelling Fellowships for 2010. Each year the Trust awards some 100 Travelling Fellowships to UK Citizens to travel overseas to undertake study projects related to their profession, trade or particular interest.

The ten categories for 2010 can be found and downloaded from wcmt.org.uk in PDF format. Applications can be made until 6th October 2009.

- The Trust was established on Sir Winston's death in 1965, as a national memorial to perpetuate his memory.
- Over 4530 people from throughout the UK have benefited from these Fellowships since 1966.
- These Fellowships allow individuals a unique opportunity for personal development, overseas travel and above all the chance to make a difference in their lives, by setting themselves a challenge and achieving it for the benefit of others in the UK.
- They are available to applicants of any age and from all walks of life, irrespective of academic or professional qualifications.
- 95 Fellowships were awarded in 2009, aged between 17 and 79.
- Grants average over £5000, covering all travel and living expenses for an overseas visit of between 4-8 weeks.
