



Victim Support Volunteers Needed in Paderborn Garrison

Victim Support is a free and confidential service offering emotional support, practical help and information to those affected by crime. The crime does not have to be reported to the police, nor be current.

This service relies heavily on volunteers throughout Germany and Holland. Once volunteers have completed the application process they will be required to attend a five day training course which will equip them with the relevant skills to support victims of crime.

Volunteers receive supervision and further training opportunities throughout their time with Victim Support and are supported by two full time members of staff who coordinate the scheme. Volunteers can work during the day, evening or at the weekend. All out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed.

We look for volunteers who are understanding, good listeners and who can get on with people of all ages, cultures and backgrounds. No previous experience of this kind of work is necessary.
