The SSAFA Forces Help Young Achiever Awards recognise the outstanding personal achievements of young people whose families are serving/resident in Western Europe, including the dependants of UKBCs. From coping admirably with illness or disability, to helping or caring for others, from fulfilling personal goals to achieving against the odds, these awards recognise exceptional individuals.

Do you know of a young person aged 5-18 years who has made a significant contribution to your community or a charitable organisation? Or maybe they have conducted an act of bravery or coped courageously with a difficult situation? Or succeeded at a creative, sporting or adventurous achievement?

**How to make a nomination**

In no more than 250 words, simply explain why you think someone you know is a young achiever. Attach your citation to the form below and post along with a photograph of the young achiever to, HQ SSAFA Forces Help Western Europe, Volunteer Projects Office, JHQ, BFPO 140 to arrive no later than Thursday 5 November 2009.

**Rules of entry**

All nominations must be made with the consent of the nominee and their parent/guardian. The Judging Panel reserves the right to check the validity of all nominations. The decisions of the Judging Panel are final. Previously recognised achievements (e.g. Duke of Edinburgh) are not eligible for nomination unless they have been developed further or used to the benefit of others.
