### **MEDICAL CENTRE OPENING HOURS** **DURING CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR (RHINE GARRISON)**

Members of the community should note that the Javelin medical centre will close from Monday 20 Dec 2010 as part of the Javelin stand down. Normal service will resume Tuesday 4 Jan 2011.

RSU Medical Centre will be opened daily, between 08.00 – 20.00 hrs, throughout Christmas and New Year standdown although with reduced staffing levels.

The Primary Care Rehabilitation Facility (PCRF) Elmpt will be closed throughout the standdown. Emergency cover only will be provided until 4 Jan 11. Contact the Medical Centre for duty team contact details. Normal service will resume 4 Jan 11.

The Department of Community Mental Health (DCMH), also located in Elmpt, will be closed throughout the standdown period. Emergency cover for urgent cases will be provided until 4 Jan 11. Contact the Medical Centre for duty team contact details. Normal service will resume 4 Jan 11.

The on-call midwife can be contacted via the RSU Medical Centre.

If you need urgent care advice Out of Hours (between 20.00 – 08.00 hrs), please ring your local medical centre. Your call will be automatically diverted to the Telephone Advice Service, manned throughout the night, by a nurse who will assess your condition and advise on the best course of action.

In a medical emergency, please call the local ambulance service using the emergency telephone number of 112.
