

Grounds Maintenance In Married Quarter Areas

With immediate effect the occupants of married quarters will be responsible for the cutting of grass and the clearing of fallen leaves in front of their own quarter.

These changes come at a time of severe financial pressure to reduce costs to the MOD wherever possible, and are in no way connected to the new arrangement with Babcock.

If you have a genuine need for assistance with your garden, especially during an operational deployment, please contact your Unit Welfare Office and they will arrange this help.

Grass will continue to be cut and leaves cleared in communal areas.

It is appreciated that some people may be disappointed with this change and may be concerned that the quarters will start to look untidy, however if everybody does their bit then there is no reason that this should be the case. If anybody does have any particular concern however, or are not clear on exactly what they are required to do, they should discuss it in the first instance with their Housing Estate Manager.
