

Dedicated Service Award – Herr Gerhard Bruns

In the beautiful setting of Church House (Germany), Herr Gerhard Bruns was presented with an award for 35 years of dedicated service to H M Armed Forces in Germany.

The award, signed by the former GOC General Mungo Melvin OBE, was presented by the Chaplain-General, Maj Gen Stephen Robbins QHC on his behalf, with Staff from MOD Chaplains (Army), Church House and many friends and supporters. *[pictured below]*

Herr Bruns has acted as a driver for British Forces in Germany since 1974 and following the closure of the Herford Coach Troop, moved this year to a newly vacated post as driver at Church House (Germany). His duties include the often anti-social details associated with the arrival and departure of visiting guests and speakers to this unique training establishment.

The Chaplain-General commended Herr Bruns for his long-standing commitment and commented that it was a remarkable and inspiring coincidence that the presentation was being made on the 70th Anniversary of the outbreak of the Second World War. He said that Herr Bruns' service to British Forces over this time was a testimony to the excellent relations now enjoyed by the British and German peoples.
