Liberated on 15 Apr 1945 by British troops, the memorial houses a memorial wall, a documentation centre and memorials to different nationalities. Anne Frank and her sister are also buried here. English films are shown in the Exhibition Centre.

Located on the grounds of the former POW (Prisoner of War) and concentration camps, you'll see marked graves and monuments hold reminders of the suffering and deaths of its prisoners. A documentation centre illustrates the history of the camp and its victims.

Cities Worth Visiting

Hamburg

The second largest city in Germany, Hamburg has wide variety of attractions to offer the visitor. From the colourful district of St Pauli to the more sedate suburb of Blankenese along romantic hillsides, from the Sunday fishmarket to the ultra modern HafenCity, it is a city of contrasts. The popular thrice yearly Dom fair is part of Hamburg's tradition. It is a world famous shopping centre with no shortage of designer and bargain shops. Delve into the Hamburg dungeons. If it is art and history you are after, there is a wide ranging selection of art galleries and museums to choose from. Daily boat trips depart from the port and tour the harbour area, offering a fascinating look at the city from the water.

Bremen

Made famous by the Grimm fairy tale of the Musicians of Bremen (whose statue is in the town square) and with 1200 years of history, this cosmopolitan city lives very much in both the present and in the past. The town hall and the massive Roland statue in the market square are UNESCO world heritage sites. The Schnoor and Böttcherstraße, with their fascinating little shops, are a trip back in time. The quayside market, shops and boat trips on offer make the Schlachte Embankment a lively place. Town centre shops, as well as the popular Waterfront and Weserpark centres are magnets for the avid shopper. Göttingen

Hannover

In the covered market in the heart of the city you can find a wide range of international foods. Hannover is not short of attractive green spaces, such as the Herrenhausen Gardens, the tree lined Maschsee Lake, Hannover Zoo with its presentation of different animal kingdoms, and its very own forest, the Eilenriede.
